PROGRESS

OUR VISIT TO TALLAHASSEE WAS A SUCCESS, THE PTF 3 RESTORATION PROJECT WAS PLACED NUMBER 39 ON THE FUNDING LIST OUT 110 COMPETING PROJECTS. THIS IS THE BIG HURDLE THAT HAD TO BE JUMPED, THE LEGISLATURE WILL VOTE ON THE FINAL BUDGET FOR THE STATE IN MAY-JUNE 2006. PROVIDED, THERE ARE NO ALTERATIONS TO THE STATE BUDGET FOR HISTORICAL PROGRAMS, PTF 3 SHOULD SEE FUNDING IN JULY-AUGUST 2006. ONCE THE DOCUMENTATION AND COMMITMENT LETTERS ARE SIGNED, \$ 350,000.00 WILL BE AVAILIBLE FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE BOAT.

THIS WAS A BIG TURN AROUND FROM LAST YEAR, THE LETTERS OF SUPPORT SENT TO THE STATE AND PARTICIPATION BY THOSE WHO WERE ABLE TO MAKE IT TO TALLAHASSEE MADE THE DIFFERENCE. THE REVIEW PROCESS IS SIMILAR TO MOST TOWN MEETINGS WITH 5 MINUTES PER PROJECT TO ANSWER QUESTIONS FROM THE BOARD. OUR TEAM MANAGE TO GET IN 15 MINUTES EXTOLLING THE HISTORICAL SIGNIFICATES OF PTF 3, STATE OFFICIALS CAN SPEAK AT ANY TIME DURING THE DAY AND AS FOR AS LONG AS THEY WANT, AND THEY DID. THIS EFFORT MOVED THE PTF 3 PROJECT FROM LAST YEARS, DEAD LAST POSITION OF # 114, TO # 39. WE APPREICATE THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION RECOGNIZING THE IMPORTANTS OF THE PTF 3 RESTORATION PROJECT, THERE ARE MANY WORTHY RESTORATION PROJECTS THAT WE HAVE COMPETED WITH, BACKED BY EQUALLY CONCERNED AND DEDICATED PEOPLE. YOU MOVE UP IN THE GRANT PROCESS BY DEMONSTRATING THAT YOU CAN KEEP YOUR PROJECT MOVING OVER A LONG PERIOD TIME, THAT YOU HAVE THE COMMITMENT TO SEE THE PROJECT TO COMPLETION.

MIKE GALE AND HIS FILM CREW FROM GREEN DOOR PRODUCTIONS FOLLOWED OUR PROGRESS THROUGH OUT THE DAY, FILMING INTERVIEWS WITH SENATOR BURT SAUNDERS, REP. RICHARD MACHEK AND ASST. DIRECTOR OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION FRED GASKE. THIS WILL BE COMPILED AS PART OF THE DOCUMENTARY ABOUT PTF 3 AND HER RESTORATION.

DNAS, THE DELAND NAVAL AIR MUSEUM, THE TEMPORARY HOME FOR PTF 3 HAS CONTINUED TO UPGRADE THEIR FACILITY. THE PTF 3 CREW WAS ABLE TO ASSIST THE MUSEUM ON 10 NOVEMBER 2005 WITH THE PLACEMENT OF AN 8,000 lbs. ANCHOR AND THE MOUNTING OF THE F-14 TOMCAT. THE WORLD WAR 2 ANCHOR WAS POSITIONED IN FRONT OF THE MUSEUM AND PAINTED HAZE GREY. THE F-14 TOMCAT, OF VF-101 OCEANA NAVAL AIR STATION, NORFOLK, VA. WAS MOVED FROM THE AIRFIELD, RIGGED AND LIFTED ONTO A HARD STAND FOR PERMANENT DISPLAY NEXT THE MUSEUM.

THIS WAS ALL PART OF THE MAD RUSH TO READY THE MUSEUM FOR THE 14th ANNUAL AIRFLEET WEEKEND CELEBRATING VETERANS DAY WITH A PARADE DOWN TOWN DELAND, A FLY OVER BY VINTAGE AIRCRAFT, HANGER DANCE AND OPEN HOUSE AT THE MUSEUM AND HANGER. THIS COINCIDED WITH THE DEDICATION OF THE BRONZE BUST OF LT. CHARLES BAILEY, 99th FIGHTER SQUADRON – TUSKEGEE AIRMAN. LT. BAILEY A LONG TIME RESIDENT OF DELAND PASSED AWAY IN 2002, HE WAS REPRESENTED BY FAMILY MEMBERS AND SURVIVING TUSKEGEE VETERANS.

LOOKING AHEAD

WE HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO ADD TO OUR STOCK OF TOOLS, THE ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFFS DEPARTMENT PURGED THEIR EVIDENCE LOCKER AND DONATED MUCH NEED TOOLS TO THE PROJECT. A PROFESSIONAL GRADE MATCO DOUBLE STACK TOOL CABINET STOCKED WITH TOOLS, ACETYLENE GAS WELDING SET, COMPUTER MONITORS AND MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS, ALL WERE EITHER FROM AN AUTO CHOP SHOP OR RECOVERED STOLEN MERCHANDISE. MATERIAL THAT WE CAN'T USE WILL BE SOLD TO RAISE FUNDS, MUCH OF THIS WILL BE PLACED ON EBAY OR PLACED ON CONSIGNMENT. THE SHERIFFS OFFICE HAS OUR WISH LIST

OF TOOLS NEED FOR THE PROJECT AND WILL TRY TO SET ASIDE AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE BEFORE THE NEXT PURGE OF THE EVIDENCE LOCKER.

WE EXPECT TO HAVE THE BRIDGE PAINTED IN CAMOUFLAGE BEFORE CHRISTMAS, WEATHER PERMITING. THE CONSTANT RAIN THAT WE HAVE RECEIVED RESULTING FROM THE LARGE AMOUNT OF HURRICANE ACTIVITY HAS CAUSED DELAYS IN PAINTING THE BRIDGE. THE MAIN ENGINE HATCH SHOULD BE COMPLETELY STRIPPED AND PAINTED BY THE FIRST OF THE YEAR.

WE ARE IN THE PROCESS OF BUILDING A HISTORICAL RECORD OF THE BOAT AND WE ARE SEEKING PHOTOS OF THE BOAT OR OF THE FIRST SERIES OF NASTY CLASS BOATS #3 – 8 THAT HAVE THE EARLY BELOW DECK CONFIGURATION. THIS WILL ASSIST IN RECREATING FEATURES OF THE BOAT THAT WILL BE HISTORICALLY ACCURATE. WE ARE ALSO LOOKING FOR ANY HISTORICAL ITEMS RELATED TO THE BOAT, THEY WILL BE COME PART OF THE MUSEUM FOR THE BOAT.
